This training is just for you and your dog!

**Patrick Callaghan's Rattlesnake Avoidance Training** is a safe, humane, and proven method to teach your dog to avoid rattlesnakes. Rattlesnakes can be found almost anywhere and their bites are quite common, dangerous and usually very expensive to treat. Patrick trains each dog to respond with aversion to the scent, sound and sight of rattlesnakes to avoid being bitten by one. Training is conducted in a controlled environment ensuring the safety of your dog as well as the safety of the muzzled or defanged rattlesnakes used in the training.
